

Who We Are

Whisker Mountain Animal Rescue is a foster-based nonprofit specializing in the care of animals that often fall through the cracks in the shelter system: neonatal kittens, seniors, community cats, pregnant animals, and those with complex medical or hospice needs.

Founded in Sedona in 2025, Whisker Mountain operates in Arizona and Wyoming and is led by rescue professionals with years of on-the-ground experience managing rural neglect cases, large-scale TNVR efforts, and medically complex rescues.



The Need We Address

Arizona is not yet a no-kill state, and when shelters are overwhelmed, special-needs animals are often the first at risk for euthanasia. Whisker Mountain intervenes to ensure these animals receive the time, care, and stability they need to survive and eventually find a loving home.

Projected Impact for 2026

- 300 animals helped through TNVR, foster and adoption
- 150 people supported through fostering and adoption



Lainey & Her Kittens

Lainey was rescued sick, pregnant, and dehydrated during a Wyoming TNVR effort.

Whisker Mountain stabilized her in foster care, ensured a safe birth, and supported her family through adoption. All kittens found a home, with Lainey being adopted with one of her bonded kittens.

When the kitten later developed FIP, Whisker Mountain stepped in again, covering her treatment and ensuring the bonded family could heal and stay together.

What We Do

- **Foster-Based Medical & Neonatal Care** For animals requiring extended or specialized treatment.
- **TNVR & Community Cat Intervention** Large-scale, humane population control in rural and underserved areas.
- **Transport, Placement & Post Adoption Support** Ensuring animals and adopters are supported well beyond placement.

Funding Priorities

- Core Operating Support (Early-Stage Capacity Building)
- Emergency and Neonatal Veterinary Care
- Foster support
- TNVR

Annual operating budget: ~\$160,000

Looking Ahead

Whisker Mountain's long-term vision is a special-needs sanctuary in Sedona where animals that require extended care due to age or medical condition can have a permanent home.
